Rheinhessen, the 'Land of a Thousand Hills', lies on the left bank of the Rhein River between Mainz, Worms and Bingen. People here are proud of their successful viticulture tradition. Its beginnings go back to the Romans who already planted vines along the banks of the Rhine River.
This gentle, open minded and innovative region is influenced by a young and ambitious generation of winemakers. Dynamic winegrowers as well as a mild and dry climate are the basis for world class wines.

Vintage Note: The 2021 harvest, more so than in previous years, was characterized by an enormous influence of regional and local weather conditions on the growth and ripening of our vines and grapes. Thanks to the excellent harvest management of our growers and the winemaking team the wines have a very pleasant aromatic profile, classic flavour and good aging potential.

Winemaking: Gentle pressing and purification of musts, fermentation with selected yeasts under temperature controlled conditions, storage in stainless steel tanks until bottling.

Wine Analysis: Alc. 9.5 % vol.
Residual Sugar 45.0 g/l
Acidity 7.9 g/l

Winemaker's Tasting Note: This wonderfully crisp late harvest Riesling combines citrus and floral aromas. It has a juicy mid-palate, perfectly balanced acidity and a rich and elegant, fruity finish.

Food Matches: It pairs nicely with light appetizers and a spicy cuisine. Serve well chilled.
